Dr. Alan Kaplan is a Family Physician practicing in Ontario, Canada and the Chair of the Family Physician Airways Group of Canada. He is a clinical lecturer at the University of Toronto and an Honorary Professor of Primary Care Respiratory Medicine of the Observational and Pragmatic Research Institute, Singapore. He has been involved in multiple respiratory initiatives locally (respiratory consultant, medical director of local Pulmonary Rehabilitation clinics), nationally (College of Family Physicians of Canada initiatives, Health Quality Ontario standards for Asthma and COPD, Board member Thrombosis Canada) and internationally (Senate member of the IPCRG, international presentations in multiple countries, Editorial Board, Journal of Pulmonary Therapy, International Editor, nPCRJ (Nature Primary Care Respiratory Journal)) and author of more than 140 peer reviewed journals and more than 110 conference abstracts. His passion is educating clinicians with practical advice for day-to-day therapy in order to optimize therapy for patients.



Dr. Mike Crooks

Dr. Mike Crooks is a Senior Clinical Lecturer and Consultant Respiratory Physician working at Hull York Medical School, University of Hull and Hull University Teaching Hospitals NHS Trust in the UK. He is Clinical Lead for the Humber Coast and Vale Respiratory Network, he chairs the Hull and East Yorkshire Respiratory Education Group and leads the SENTINEL programme. He leads the Hull and East Yorkshire Integrated COPD Service and is a member of the local airways service. He undertakes research relating to the diagnosis and management of airways diseases, such as asthma and COPD, and their exacerbations, as well as undertaking research related to breathlessness and tobacco cessation. Additionally, since the emergence of COVID-19, Dr Crooks has worked collaboratively to improve our understanding about the acute and long-term effects of COVID-19 and its treatment.
