Report: 8th ILD Update 2024 (Virtual Event)

The 8th Interstitial Lung Disease (ILD) Update 2024, held virtually via Zoom platform, was a successful and well-attended course. A total of 370 participants registered for the course, including 5 international participants from Vietnam and Indonesia.

The course featured 33 speakers, comprising 15 international and 18 Malaysian speakers, representing a wide range of disciplines. Besides respiratory medicine, the course included contributions from experts in thoracic radiology, pathology, rheumatology, lung transplant surgery, nephrology, cardiology, oncology, and palliative medicine.

Attendance remained strong throughout the event, with more than 50% of registered participants actively engaging in almost all the sessions. The interactive nature of the multidisciplinary discussions and the HRCT Quiz was particularly well-received, encouraging meaningful exchanges between participants and speakers.

All registered participants will have access to the recorded lectures for a period of three months after the course. The access will be emailed after 2-weeks by the organiser. This also to allow for registered participants who were unable to log in during the 3-whole day course.

Overall, the course proceeded smoothly, and feedback from participants highlighted the value of the interactive format and the knowledge shared by the experts.
