Senior Consultant Pulmonologist
Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia Medical Centre

Assoc. Prof. Dr. Andrea Ban Yu-Lin is a senior consultant physician and pulmonologist in Hospital Tuanku Muhriz Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia (HCTM UKM), specializing in asthma and COPD. She is the current head of respiratory unit in the department of medicine. She obtained her masters in medicine (MMED) from Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia and has since become a lecturer, physician and researcher in HCTM. She has conducted researches particularly in asthma, COPD and tuberculosis.

She has published and presented in national and international congresses. She is a member of the Malaysian Thoracic Society (MTS) and Malaysian Association for Bronchology and Interventional Pulmonology (MABIP). She was previously the chairperson of the national respiratory exit viva exam committee and the chairperson for current national asthma clinical practice guidelines for adults. She serves as an associate editor for the journal *respirology case report*.

Prof. Ng Heng Joo is a senior consultant and Head of the Department of Haematology, Singapore General Hospital. He is a Clinical Professor with the Duke–National University of Singapore School of Medicine, and clinical lecturer with the Yong Loo Lin School of Medicine, National University of Singapore.

Dr Ng's research interests and publications focus on various aspects of thrombosis and haemostasis, and include investigating the optimization of treatment, monitoring and prophylaxis of venous thromboembolic diseases, as well as therapeutic intervention for bleeding disorders. He also has an interest in patient safety and is the Director of Patient Safety, Singapore General Hospital.

A graduate of University Putra Malaysia (UPM) and University of Malaya, **Dr. Tan Jiunn Liang** is currently a Consultant Chest Physician in University of Malaya Medical Centre (UMMC) & UM Specialist Centre (UMSC), Kuala Lumpur. Before joining UMMC he started his medical career in Hospital Tengku Ampuan Afzan, Kuantan. He attained his Master in Internal Medicine degree in University Malaya in 2014 and later completed his Fellowship training in Respiriology in 2018.

Dr. Tan is an active clinical researcher, having completed several studies including SCENT Study (Lung Cancer screening), Pneumonia Admission Audit, Latent TB study, ALK (IHC) study, FLASH study (COPD) and Severe Asthma study in the last few years with several other ongoing studies. His keen interest in Respiriology has seen him win several awards; APSR-IASLC Book Prize at the 20th Congress of the Asia Pacific Society of Respiriology, Young Investigator Award from the International Study of Lung Cancer (IASLC) during the 6th Asia Pacific Lung Cancer Conference and First Prize for Oral Free Paper Presentation in the Malaysian Thoracic Society Annual Scientific Meeting.
